

Tennessee Society DAR Scholarship 2010 – 2011
Application Information Sheet

Amount Awarded: \$2500, payable to the college/university (\$1250 in fall semester, \$1250 in Spring semester) when notice of enrollment from the university Registrar's Office is received by the Tennessee Society DAR State Treasurer.

The Tennessee Society DAR Scholarship applicant must be a U.S. citizen and a current Tennessee resident planning to attend an accredited college/university granting a degree. This may be a nursing school or junior college, but not a vocational school.

The application deadline is on or before January 15, 2011.

Please submit **two copies of the application** with all supporting documentation to the sponsoring chapter Scholarship Chairman.

The following information is to be assembled by the student, working with the college or guidance counselor at the applicant's high school:

Cover Sheet

- Name of Scholarship
- Student's name, address, telephone number and e-mail address
- College or Guidance Counselor name
- High school name and address
- Sponsoring DAR Chapter name; name and address of Chapter Regent or Chapter Scholarship Chairman

Essay

Each applicant must write an essay of 150 to 300 words, double-spaced, on the subject, "My Chosen Profession: My Preparation, My Immediate Need, My Hope."

Birth Certificate (a copy)

Official transcripts showing grades for seven semesters (if possible), class ranking, and ACT and/or SAT scores.

Resume including school, church, and community activities; employment, awards, etc.

Two letters of recommendation from a minister, Scout leader, employer, or educator.

On or before January 15, 2011, send two copies of the completed application with all supporting documentation in one packet to the Chapter Regent or Chapter Scholarship Chairman and Chapter listed below:
