4k celebrated the 100th day of school by reading stories, playing hopscotch, making t-shirts and crowns, building towers with 100 cups, and much more!



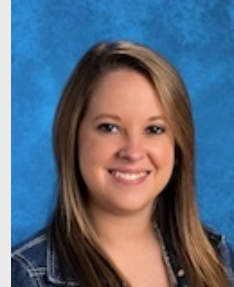
HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER SPOTLIGHT
