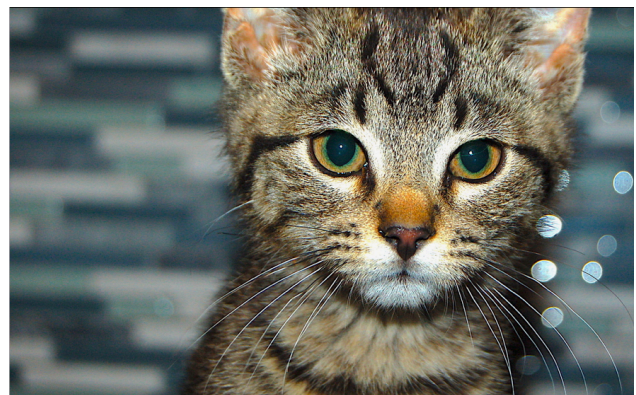
Nathan's most memorable moment was a block during a game. *"My first block has been my most memorable moment. I remember it getting the whole team hyped."*

Why We're Crazy for This Musical

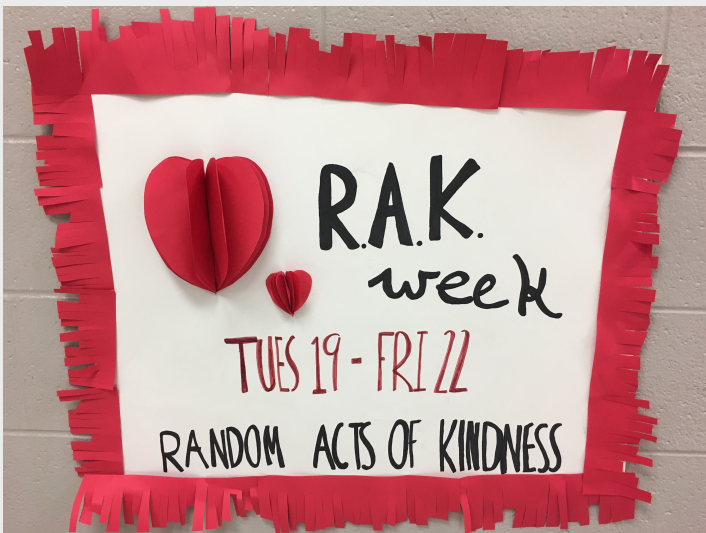

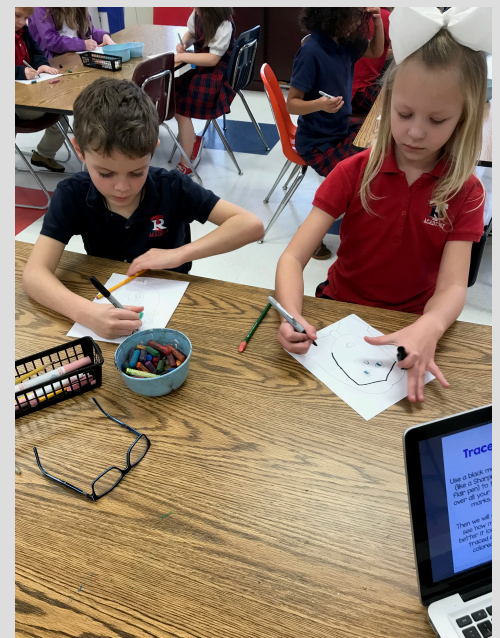
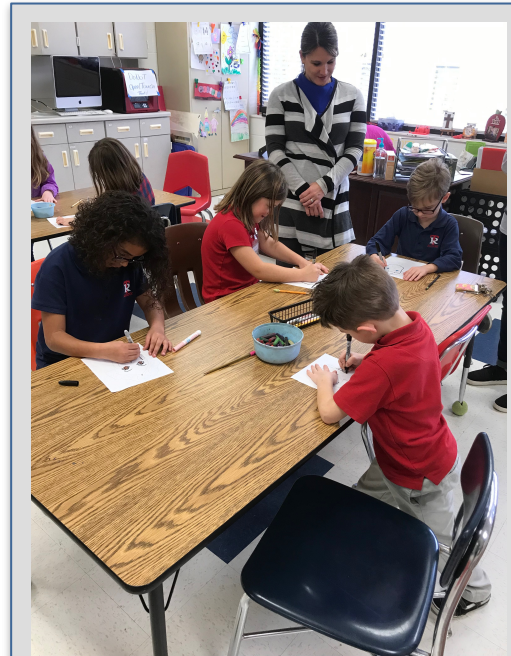
This week in the elementary..
