Lalanía and her husband Cary, were recently selected as the Millington Star's 2018 "Man and Woman of the Year" for Millington, Tn. for their faithful service and leadership roles in the Millington and Memphis communities. Lalanía is a 1992 graduate from Lambuth University with a Bachelor of Science in Vocal Performance. She was also the 1991 Miss Lambuth University and represented the University in the Miss Tennessee America Pageant. While at Lambuth, she spent much of her time performing with the Lambuth Theatre Department. Throughout her theatre career, she has performed in over 28 musical productions with such theaters as the Springer Opera House in Columbus, Ga., Springwood Theatre in West Point, Ga., the Jackson Theatre Guild in Jackson, Tn., Bellevue Baptist in Memphis, Tn. and most recently Playhouse 51 in Millington, Tn. where she revived the role of "Parsy Cline" in *A Closer Walk with Parsy Cline* (2011). Lalanía has been selected six times by the Tennessee Governor's School for the Arts as an 'Outstanding Music Educator in Tennessee.' Last year, she also received a U.S. Congressional commendation for her 20 years of dedication to TRA Fine Arts and her service as an "Advocate for the Arts" across Tennessee and the U.S. She served as President for the West Tn. Vocal Music Educators Association 2014-2016 and is currently serving on the WTVMRA Executive Council and Music Education Council. She is a member of MENC (National Association for Music Education), INMEA (Tennessee Music Educators Association), ETA Educational Theatre Association and is a 2012/ 2015 Alumni of the Tennessee Arts Academy for Fine Arts. Lalanía has directed 32 shows with the TRA Theatre Department and she is a six-time nominee for the Orpheum Theatre's "Outstanding Musical Direction" Award. This past Spring, TRA's "Crazy For You" under her direction was nominated for 12 Outstanding Orpheum HSMIA nominations and TRA won for "Best Choreography." In Spring 2016, she won the "Outstanding Music Direction" award for TRA's "Seven Brides for Seven Brothers", which was also nominated for "Best Over-all Production." TRA's world-premiere musical "An Evening with the Characters of Pride and Prejudice" under her direction, was also nominated for the Orpheum's 2015 "Best Over-all Production" and "Best Musical Direction" and she was nominated "Best Musical Direction" for TRA's 2017 "Oklahoma" and 2018 "Guys and Dolls." Many of her students have received national recognition in Music and Theatre. Lalanía has two Solo Contemporary Christian CD projects, three American Worship CDs and is a featured soloist on 6 of the Bellevue Baptist Choir CDs. She has been an active member of the Bellevue Sanctuary Choir, Women's Ministry Praise Team and a featured soloist on Sunday mornings for 25 years and now serves alongside her husband in ministry at Community Baptist Church in Rosemark, Tn. She has been married 28 years to her husband Cary, who serves as CEO of Love Worth Finding Ministries in Cordova, Tn. and Pastor of Community Baptist Church. 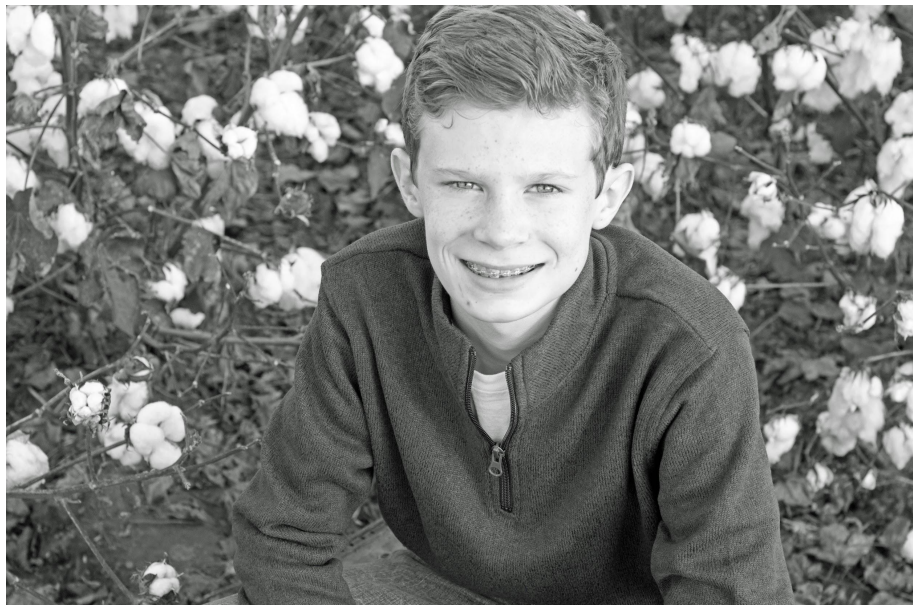
